An actor, dressed as Big Bear stretches their arms.

[Audio: Big Bear]

A second actor, dressed as Little Bear ducks and holds their arms to their body.

[Audio: Little Bear]

The video cuts to a puppet of a little bear wearing a red woolly hat. They are balancing on a snowball on one leg.

[Audio: Bear puppet: Ta-dah! Haha!]

The puppet begins to stumble.

[Audio: Bear puppet: Whoa, whoa, whoa, oof!]

They fall into a seating position.

[Audio: Little Bear: Yawn!]

A wide shot shows the stage split in two. To the left, Big Bear is sleeping whilst to the right, Little Bear stretches their arms and yawns.

[Audio: Little Bear: Party!]

The video zooms into Little Bear who begins to dance with excitement.

[Audio: Little Bear: Tomorrow!]

A close-up shows Little Bear appearing from behind the set.

[Audio: Little Bear: Please come]

[Audio: Big and Little Bear: Woooooooooah!]

The video cuts to Big and Little Bear, arms outstretched, leaning to their right whilst shaking their hands and fingers.

[Audio: Big Bear: Home]

A close-up shows Big Bear wearing a scarf whilst holding a flask.

[Audio: Bear puppet: Woah, woah, woah]

The bear puppet is running on top of a large snowball before flipping forwards whilst continuing to land on the snowball.

[Audio: Little Bear: Yah, yah]

In a wide shot, Little Bear throws snowballs at Big Bear who is hiding behind several large containers.

[Audio: Little Bear: Kaw, kaw]

The video cuts to Little Bear, arms outstretched, with a scarf around them which is being held by Big Bear. This is followed by a series of clips including Little Bear dancing, Big Bear rubbing their backside against a post, and a wide shot of Big Bear rolling onto their back.

[Audio: Bear puppet: Hmm]

A close-up shows the bear puppet raising their arm across their forehead as if looking for something and moving their head from left to right. A further clip shows Little Bear putting a stick in their right ear and jiggling this to mimic cleaning ahead of a video showing Big Bear playing the recorder.

[Audio: Fish: Blub, blub, blub, blub]

Puppets of several fish move across the video as they make noises. A close-up of a goldfish is moved towards a container where it mimics eating food.

[Audio: Big Bear: Party. Little Bear]

Big Bear holds a Magic Tree air freshener as they sit behind the wheel of a car.

[Audio: the background music changes to a jingly tune]

A toy car is moved down a pole where Little Bear becomes visible, pulling a face as if they are about to sneeze as the car drives over their nose.

[Audio: Bear puppet: Hah, yo. Bye]

A close-up shows the bear puppet wearing a party hat as they bow and raise their hands to wave. They jump down as the screen fades to black.

[Audio: audience applause]
